January minutes approved

Finances: Bob gave the financial report for January. Compared to January 2018, this January's income was higher by \$1,718, expenses were higher by \$959, and overall total was higher by \$759. As planned in January's meeting, \$10,500 was transferred to build a higher prudent reserve which now comes to \$17,105. Financial report was approved.

Liaison: Perry stated it was an oversight for the Service Auction to be scheduled on the same date as the District 9 Business Meeting. Joe will give the CO report at District. Perry is working on condensing the Area 4 meeting list, which is a huge document. It is now 4 pages (down from 7). Perry wants us to remember the SOS (Sharing Our Sobriety) program, and give back in support of CO when you or someone you know has a AA birthday.

Volunteer and office report: Two in-house volunteer shifts are currently available. 1. Monday afternoon 2 to 6p.m. 2. Thursday afternoon 2 to 6p.m. The only requirement to volunteer at CO is sponsor approval.

Activities: Bob gave the Event Financials report. Total net gains for Area 4 Assembly, Blytheville Coon Supper, and Winter Holiday came to \$241 (see spreadsheet for more info).
