There are a lot of keys floating around out there that have not been returned after in-house volunteers quit working at the office. Bob and Perry went over how they are paid and explained a sort of balloon payment.

What About Bob? Perry, your Central Office Liaison took a trip to Fort Smith to get the word out about Central Office and to try and sign up folks for the 12-steppers list and other service opportunities. While he was there he visited the District 13(Hispanic) meeting. He also visited the Fort Smith Intergroup office and found out that they have their very own Bob running their office just like we do. Perry has put together a nice tri-fold display for Area conventions and other meetings. It will be at Old Grandad. Perry is continuing to travel the state and local meetings. We have had over 20 12-step calls per month for the last three months and we get calls from all over the state, so we need to have 12-steppers from all over.
