Central Office's Primary Purpose Is To Help The Still Suffering Alcoholic

Our #1 goal is to help the still suffering alcoholic. The best way to help them is to get them a 12-stepper. Some volunteers are more successful getting 12-steppers involved. Here are the ways they do it.

1. If you suspect a caller is new or coming back or they ask about a meeting, ask them, "Are you new in the program?"
2. If they are new or coming back *Tell Them* (Don't ask) you will have someone call them to answer all the many questions they have about A.A. Don't open the door for them to say they don't need help.
3. If they refuse the call talk to them about their experiences and your own, then suggest someone calling them again.
4. Keep talking and try to have someone call them if you feel you can.

If they are asking for a meeting? Get them a 12- stepper!
